The server blades will each be contained in a custom windowed case featuring the *World of Warcraft* logo and offering a view of the computer hardware inside. They will also come with a commemorative plaque signed by the *World of Warcraft* team, making each one a true collector's item.

The server blades will be auctioned in batches over the course of four weeks, beginning on October 17, 2011. Auctions will take place on eBay and will be managed by Kompolt[®], a world leader specializing in online charity auctions.
